




What is your preferred method to provide feedback?





Not sure of the benefits of be a leader




AASHTOWare Project Strategic Plan Update




A question was submitted on original AASHTOWare Project requirements

- AASHTOWare Project web development started over 10 years ago
 - Technical Review Teams outlined original requirements
 - Not all original requested requirements were delivered
 - The PTF had to make tough decisions based on budget and schedule constraints
 - Focus was on requirements that met needs of the majority (80% rule)
- Since then, the PTF shifted focus towards:
 - Requirements identified during agency implementations
 - Enhancements identified in PUG Ballots
 - Strategic and proactive initiatives
- No current plans to revisit original requested requirements
- Is the PTF missing the mark, should we prioritize the original requirements?



I believe time commitment was the number 1 objection to joining the different committees. Can any of the PTF members speak to how they were able to balance current responsibilities with Task Force related responsibilities?

is either the Odata API or a 3rd party interface 2-way? Meaning can data be given and received by AWP?

how much trouble have other agencies had in migrating from SiteManager to Project Construction and Materials? Our upgrade/implementation has been active for over 15 months, and we have yet to run a migration of our SiteManager database to C & M

But should cost drive functionality? If people want it, it should go in to the system.

Great information and we should have these sessions every 5 months


Could extracting initial item quantities from the plans be one example where AWP could interface with BIM/CIM products?
